Part of the donation will be invested in a stepping fretsaw, which is particularly well suited for use at a school for the physically disabled. It promotes sawing, drilling and grinding using personal strength, and therefore prepares the “big” pupils for life after the school.

Additionally, a long-standing wish is also being fulfilled: A whiteboard will soon be put to use in the classroom. The board is able to interpret the user’s finger as a mouse, whilst a pen can also be used to write or draw on or directly in applications.

With the next visit, WINAICO will receive a demonstration of the stepping fretsaw and the whiteboard from the pupils. Both parties are looking forward to regular visits in the future.
